RELAY SAILING

Starting box. The line on this box is important for the first boat sailing and the last boat in a team.

First boat starts here. The last boat of the team finishes here.

Finishing Box for 1st & 2nd boat.

Finishes at the orange marker finish line. (1st set of markers in the grid pattern.) When they sail over the orange marker line, they call to their next team member to go / start at the yellow line under normal racing rules.

The centre markers in the grid are for an invisible wall, to divide starting and finishing yachts. Not really to sail through.

Area 1. There should only really be the yachts starting in this zone.

Area 2. This will have boats sailing through after finishing and the last members of a team sailing to the yellow finish line.

All other yachts to stay clear.

The last team member after rounding the last marker 4, must sail upwind across yellow marker finish line to finish the race.

To do this.

Other makers after last rounding marker 4 do not have to be sailed through or around.
